

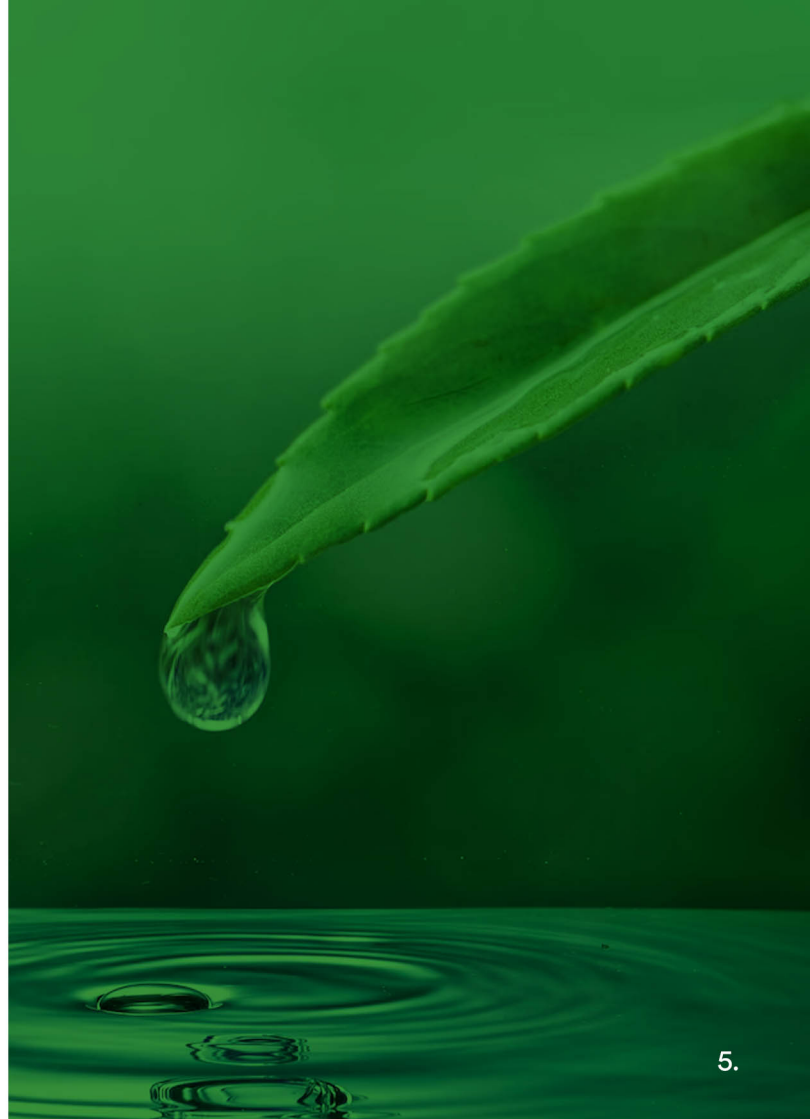
What we believe

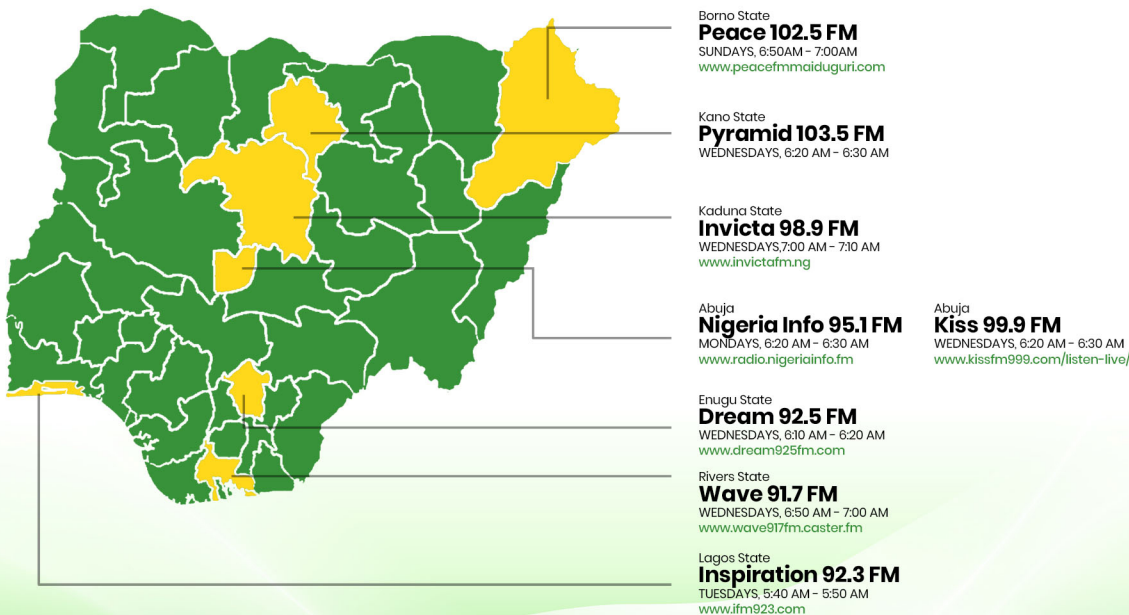
