
For me, in crisis or tough times, my anchor verse has always been Romans 8:28:


Our text is taken from
PHILIPPIANS 3:10

¹⁰ I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death...” (NIV)

Apostle Paul defines a life for Christ as one that participates in all aspects; His resurrection, His suffering and His death. He defines knowing Christ as a practical participation in all these three.
