Programs and Initiatives



Jesus at Your Door (JAYD):

This flagship outreach focuses on addressing physical and spiritual needs in vulnerable communities. Inspired by Matthew 25:35-40, JAYD emphasizes providing food, clothing, and prayers while fostering a deeper connection with Christ.



Set the Captives Free:

Through this program, Wellspring ministers to the sick by visiting hospitals and homes, praying with patients, and offering financial assistance for medical bills. The initiative embodies compassion and hope for those in their darkest hours.



The Brethren Project:

This program supports missionaries and servants of God by providing financial aid, resources for building projects, crusades, and evangelism initiatives. It strengthens the propagation of the Gospel through critical interventions.



Monthly Breakfast Meetings:

This fellowship brings Christians from various denominations together monthly for worship, sharing God's Word, and breaking bread in an atmosphere of joy and unity.



Devotional

Jesus at Your Door (JAYD):

Wellspring of Life Global Outreach has significantly impacted vulnerable communities through its initiatives, notably distributing over 5,000 food packages across 75 communities in Abuja and its environs. These packages included essential staples such as rice, tomato paste, cooking oil, and other foodstuffs vital for sustenance. This initiative was not merely an act of charity but a deliberate effort to combat hunger and provide immediate relief to struggling families. Each package represented more than physical nourishment; it was a message of hope and compassion, embodying the love and care that underpin Wellspring's mission.

The organization has reached over 25,000 individuals through a combination of food aid, prayers, and unconditional cash transfers. These cash transfers were directed toward the most vulnerable, empowering recipients to address their unique needs. Beyond the material assistance, Wellspring also prioritized the spiritual well-being of those served, offering prayers and messages of hope. This holistic approach addressed not only physical needs but also fostered spiritual and emotional resilience among beneficiaries.

Stories for Change

During the Jesus at Your Door outreach in Mashafa, a rural and rocky community in Mpape, Abuja, while distributing food hampers to the residents, we came across a woman who invited us into her home. She showed us an almost empty pot of food, which was meant to serve as lunch and dinner for her four children—a meal so small it could barely feed one child.

As we spoke with her, she shared that her husband had left her to raise and care for their four children alone. She explained that she and her children often survive by relying on the goodwill of their neighbors, and sometimes through begging.

After we prayed with her and handed her the food hamper, the visibly emotional woman broke down in uncontrollable tears. This moved everyone around her to tears as well. She thanked the team, acknowledging that Jesus had truly come to her door through the Wellspring of Life team.

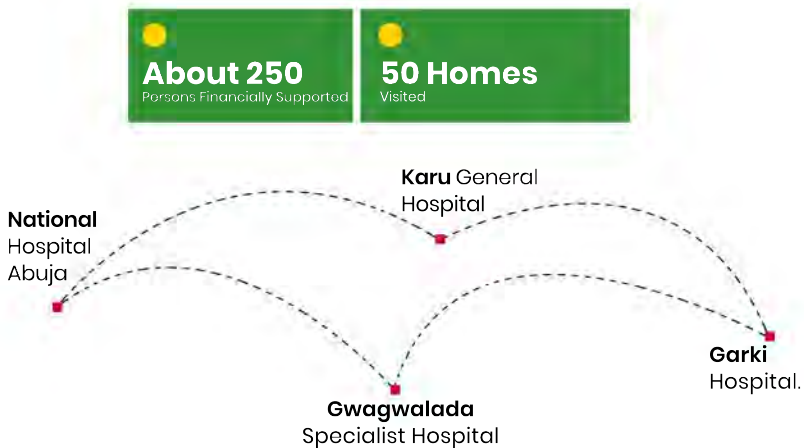


Set the Captives Free:

Wellspring of Life Global Outreach has made a profound difference in the lives of over 250 individuals by providing financial support for medical bills. Beneficiaries received assistance at notable healthcare facilities, including Karu General Hospital, National Hospital Abuja, Gwagwalada Specialist Hospital, and Garki Hospital. This support alleviated the financial burdens on families facing medical crises, enabling them to access essential treatments and focus on recovery. Each intervention was accompanied by prayers and encouragement, reflecting Wellspring's holistic commitment to healing both body and spirit.

In addition to hospital interventions, the organization visited 50 homes, extending its mission of hope and compassion directly to families in need. These visits were not just about material support; they were opportunities to connect with individuals on a personal level. Families received essential items and spiritual guidance, which brought solace during challenging times. By meeting people where they were, Wellspring ensured its outreach was both impactful and deeply personal.

Stories for Change

Amos was admitted to Maitama General Hospital for a rare ailment. After weeks of treatment, he was healed, but his total bill had amounted to 250,000. When we met him three months later, he was still being held captive by the hospital, earning him the unenviable nickname of "Landlord." The hospital security had received explicit orders not to allow him to leave until the outstanding bill was paid.

When the Wellspring team visited him, we prayed with him, provided for his basic needs, and cleared the entire bill. Amos could hardly contain his joy. With tears in his eyes, he ran through the hospital halls shouting, "I am free!" His overwhelming sense of relief and gratitude was a testament to the impact of our intervention.

Impact Highlights (2013 - 2024)

The Brethren Project:

Wellspring of Life Global Outreach has actively supported missionaries and local churches in advancing the Gospel by providing funding for building projects, crusades, and other evangelistic initiatives. This support has enabled the growth of the Body of Christ, especially in remote areas, by strengthening both the spiritual and physical capacities of these communities. By addressing practical needs alongside spiritual goals, Wellspring has empowered local ministries to expand their reach and impact, ensuring the Gospel message is shared effectively.

In 2022, Wellspring of Life took a monumental step in community development by constructing a school in the Chigbodo community of Abuja. This project was born out of a vision to provide education and opportunities for children who might otherwise have been deprived. The school has since become a beacon of hope, transforming the lives of many children by giving them access to quality education. Through this initiative, Wellspring has demonstrated its commitment to fostering long-term societal change and uplifting future generations.

Monthly Breakfast Meetings:

Our monthly breakfast meeting has consistently gathered hundreds of thirsty souls at its monthly fellowship meetings, creating a vibrant environment for worship, spiritual learning, and meaningful fellowship. These gatherings have served as a powerful platform to unite Christians from various denominations, fostering a sense of shared purpose and collective faith. Participants experience spiritual enrichment through worship sessions, teachings, and the opportunity to connect with like-minded believers. By emphasizing unity and spiritual growth, Wellspring has successfully nurtured a supportive and inclusive community, strengthened the faith and resilience of attendees while deepening their relationships with God.

Devotional

Through the Water for the thirsty soul devotional, Wellspring of life global outreach was able to provide daily guidance and directions to people who needed it the most, the devotional contained timely words to spoke to their situations, inspired hope and gave them the courage to continue in faith.

Radio Program

Between 2016 and 2019, over 12 million people were reached weekly through the water for the thirsty soul radio program in 7 states across the 6 geopolitical zones in Nigeria. Through the dedicated prayer line, over 10000 people where prayed with.



Looking Forward



Expanding the Jesus at Your Door (JAYD) Initiative

Wellspring of Life Global Outreach plans to significantly expand the Jesus at Your Door (JAYD) initiative, aiming to reach more underserved communities across Nigeria and even extend its operations internationally. This program, which has already impacted over 25,000 individuals, focuses on providing immediate relief through food packages, cash assistance, and prayers. The future scope of JAYD includes increased geographic coverage, targeting areas with the highest levels of poverty and deprivation. Wellspring intends to introduce innovative distribution methods and strengthen its volunteer network to ensure efficiency and greater impact. The organization also plans to integrate skill acquisition and empowerment workshops into this initiative, fostering sustainable development alongside immediate support.

Scaling Medical Interventions with Set the Captives Free

The Set the Captives Free program, known for supporting over 250 individuals through hospital bill payments, is poised for expansion. Wellspring aims to provide medical assistance to more patients in remote and underprivileged areas. The organization plans to collaborate with healthcare providers to negotiate discounted treatment costs, thereby maximizing its reach. It also intends to increase its visits to homes of the ailing, delivering not just financial aid but essential medical supplies and spiritual counseling, amplifying its holistic approach to health and healing.

Establishing Additional Educational Facilities

Recognizing the transformative power of education, Wellspring is committed to building more schools, inspired by the success of its facility in the Chigbodo community. These educational projects will target regions with limited access to formal schooling, focusing on marginalized and vulnerable children. The new facilities will emphasize not only academic excellence but also moral and spiritual growth. Collaborations with local communities will ensure sustainability and foster a sense of ownership among beneficiaries.

Strengthening the Brethren Project

The Brethren Project has been instrumental in supporting missionaries and local churches, and Wellspring aims to broaden its impact. The future include increasing funding large-scale evangelistic activities like crusades and outreach programs. Wellspring also intends to support infrastructure development for remote churches, ensuring they have adequate facilities to accommodate growing congregations.

Enhancing the Monthly Breakfast Meetings

The Monthly Breakfast Meetings have fostered unity among Christians from various denominations, and Wellspring intends to scale this initiative further. Plans include introducing virtual gatherings to accommodate participants from different locations. The organization aims to enhance the spiritual depth of these meetings by inviting renowned speakers and worship leaders. This initiative will also serve as a space for networking and collaboration, empowering participants to take active roles in their communities.
